

This term Bobcats are learning about...



English

Alongside our phonics and spelling work, our English work will include:

- After reading 'Duffy's Lucky Escape', the children will retell the story using Talk for Writing approach with story maps.
 - Throughout the work on Our Wonderful World there will be a focus on setting descriptions, information texts and a letter to the Earth.
- Other texts: Dear Earth, Somebody Swallowed Stanley, The Sea below my Toes.

Maths

During the Spring term we will be covering the following curriculum areas:

- Place Value of numbers up to 20 focusing on the teens numbers.
- Addition and Subtraction: exploring fact families of numbers within 20 and finding number bonds.
- Place Value of numbers within 50: comparing, ordering, reading and writing numbers.
- Measurement focus on length, height, mass and volume.

Computing

Cross-curricular:

We will use the internet to research our curriculum work about Our Wonderful World.

Programming a Robot:

The children will be introduced to early programming concepts. They will explore using individual commands, with each other and as part of a program. They will also use a floor robot.

Data and Information – Grouping data:

The children will be introduced to data and information. They will learn about labelling, grouping, and searching. They will look at how computers are able to group and present data.

Our Wonderful World



Science

This term the children will learn about Animals (including animals in the ocean) and continue work on Seasonal Changes. We will:

- Identify animals within different animal groups.
- Identify and describe their common features, diets and how animals should be cared for.
- Name common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Recap previous observations about Autumn, explore and discuss the changes across Winter and Spring.

Geography/History

In Geography they will learn about the Oceans and Continents using a globe, maps and atlases to support their learning. We will explore the problems with pollution in the oceans and what we can do about it.

There will also be a focus on features of the UK including its coastlines and the dangers of the coast.

In History the children will learn about Grace Darling, an inspirational figure of the past and the history of the RNLI as we look at the dangers of the coast, past and present.

Art and Design

In art, children will explore line and shape using sketching pencils. They will explore and make simple weather motifs and use the collagraph method to design and make a simple print block to make single and repeated patterns.

PSHE

'Belonging to a Community' – We will discuss what rules are, think about caring for others' needs and looking after the environment.

'Money and Work' – We will discuss the different jobs people do.

'Physical Health and Wellbeing' – We will discuss why it is important to eat healthily and exercise, including staying safe in the sun.

Design and Technology

In Design and Technology, children will use templates and learn joining techniques to create finger puppets with a focus on textiles.

Music

The children will be exploring how sounds can be produced in different ways using voices and instruments. They will listen to music and recognise how composers use dynamics, tempo and timbre to bring a character to life! They will sing simple songs adding facial expressions and actions.

R.E.

Children will continue to learn about religious beliefs and practices. The focus this term will be 'Symbols in religious worship and practice'. We will learn from studying churches and synagogues about the use of a place of worship. We will know about worship at a church and a synagogue, including the symbols, artefacts, music, holy books and other things that happen there. They will also learn about weddings in Jewish and Christian holy buildings.

Spanish

Children will start the next phase of their language learning with Mrs Fawcett learning how to say colour names.

P.E.

The children have two P.E. sessions a week (Tuesday and Wednesday). The focus will be Gymnastics skills moving onto Ball Skills and Striking and Fielding Games in the second half of the term.
