Implementation – How do we achieve our aims?

PLANNING

Follow a clearly sequenced and progressive program of study based on the National Curriculum objectives

TEACHING

High quality teaching that is appropriately pitched to individuals and is adapted to account for disabilities where needed

Extended swimming provision that starts from KS1 and is evident in every KS2 class annually
