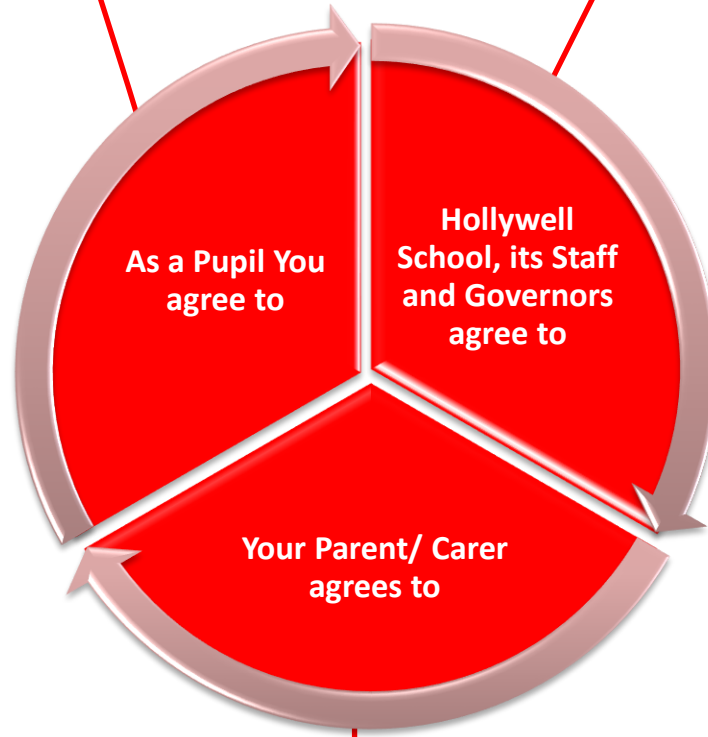




Home – School Agreement

- ✓ Take care of your appearance and wear school uniform

- ✓ Set a good example to others
- ✓ Complete home learning tasks on time and to the best of your ability
- ✓ Listen to all adults in the school and carryout any instructions or requests quickly and to the best of your ability

- ✓ Keep to school rules
- ✓ Tell the teachers if you have any worries
- ✓ Show self-control and behave in a responsible manner

- ✓ Send your child prepared for school in the appropriate uniform and with the correct equipment on time, every day.
- ✓ Ensure your child is well when they attend school informing the school of any absences **as soon as possible**
- ✓ Be an active part of your child's education and support the school ethos
- ✓ Encourage your child to have good behaviour, be polite and show respect for others and the property of others
- ✓ Encourage your child's learning in all areas and support them with home based tasks

- ✓ Collect your child punctually and advise the school if you are going to be late
- ✓ Attend parents meetings and support school activities wherever possible
- ✓ Inform the school of any issues which might affect your child's work or behaviour and report any concerns your child has that you feel relevant
