CELEBRATIONS

<p><u>Celebration time</u> Pupils will learn about what a celebration is, what happens at harvest and will explore why we should be thankful. They will explore Christmas and birthday celebrations.</p> <p><u>Easter Celebrations</u> Pupils will explore what happened to Jesus at Easter.</p>	<p><u>Celebrations and festivals</u> Pupils will learn about annual and weekly celebrations for Christians and Jewish people.</p>	<p><u>Believing</u> Pupils will learn some Jewish peoples' ideas about God and the story of creation. They will find out about the importance of Shabbat.</p>	<p><u>Beliefs and questions</u> Pupils will learn about the Bible stories that lie behind the celebrations of Christmas, Easter, Pentecost and Harvest.</p>	<p><u>Religion, family, community, worship, celebration: ways of living</u> Pupils will gain knowledge about Hindu worship and celebration including detailed information about the celebration of Diwali. They will explore Hindu ideas about Gods and Goddesses.</p> <p><u>Symbols and religious expression</u> Pupils will learn about pilgrimages and religious journeys. They will learn about local places and reflect upon what kind of pilgrimages these represent.</p>	<p><u>Religion, worldviews, family and community</u> Pupils will learn about the statistics of world religions in the local area, county, region, nation and world.</p>

<p><u>Jesus' stories and Old Testament stories</u> Pupils will explore the stories of The Wise and Foolish Builders and The Good Samaritan.</p> <p>↓</p> <p><u>Jesus' miracles</u> Pupils will explore biblical stories that focus on miracles.</p>	<p><u>Beliefs and teachings</u> Pupils will learn about some stories of Jesus and they will learn that these stories matter to Christians because of who they believe Jesus was.</p>	<p><u>Story</u> Pupils will learn about Jewish and Christian stories. They will gain knowledge about the Jewish Bible and the importance of the Torah.</p>	<p><u>Religion, family and community:</u> <u>Prayer</u> Pupils will learn about the practice, meaning and importance of the five daily Islamic prayers.</p>	<p><u>The journey of life and death</u> Pupils will learn key ways in which Christians, Hindus and Muslims see life as a journey.</p>	<p><u>Religion and the individual</u> Pupils will explore the ways Christians use some examples of the Bible texts to guide them in facing life's challenges.</p> <p>↓</p> <p><u>Beliefs and questions</u> Pupils will learn about different ideas and forms of expression in relation to belief about God in Muslim and Hindu life.</p>	<p><u>Inspirations & Aspirations</u> Pupils will learn to understand two selected texts from the scriptures of two religions. They will also learn about two contemporary members of each of the faith communities who are seeking to live out these texts and their values.</p>

ART AND CULTURE

<u>Symbols in religious worship and practice</u> Pupils will learn from visiting and studying churches and synagogues. They will learn about weddings in Jewish and Christian holy buildings.	<u>Worship and sacred places</u> Pupils will pursue an enquiry into local places of worship and beliefs about worship, relating the meaning of symbols and actions used in worship to events and teachings from the religions they study.	<u>Spiritual expression</u> Pupils will explore different examples of the music of the Christian community, explored in depth of spiritual expression and worship.	<u>Beliefs in action in the world</u> Pupils will learn about some great examples of religious architecture from across the world.	<u>Beliefs and action in the world</u> Pupils will learn about pre-war Jewish life and the impact of persecution and discrimination on Jewish people living in Germany in the 1930s. Pupils will learn about spiritual concepts of justice, fairness, compassion and responsibility. They will discover and explore the teaching and practice of looking after the planet and caring for the earth and all its creatures.
