This term we are learning about...



R.E: This term we will be learning about some examples of religious architecture from across the world and how Christianity has an impact on different individuals when facing challenges through life.

DT: In our discrete blocked project we will be using pneumatics to create moving mechanisms.

Art: Over this term the children will be learning about the artform of weaving and how it has developed over time. We will also be using lines, light and shading to create Viking knots

Maths:

Across each term 1, we cover the following Blocks set within the Year 5 National Curriculum taught through Mastery Maths:

- *Number: Place value
- *Number: Addition and Subtraction
- *Statistics: Interpreting Graphs Charts and Tables

Spanish:

Revise numbers, colours and greetings, whilst learning new vocabulary related to household pets in this exciting language now taught in school.

English:

Alongside our grammar and spelling work, our written work will encompass the themes of

*Adventure Narrative: Writing in role as characters from the story and extending story themes exploring devices that change pace in our writing

*Instructions: explore instructional text for take care of a dragon

*Persuasion: Preparing your warriors for war - writing a speech

*Poetry: Creating acrostic poems based on character profiles

Curriculum

Invaders: The Anglo-Saxons & Vikings

We are going to study the main aspects of the lives of the Anglo-Saxons including where they were from, why they came, how they lived, the burial at Sutton Hoo and Alfred the Great's conflicts with the first Vikings. We will then move into the Viking Age with a look at long ships, battles, religion and how they lived alongside the Anglo-Saxons whilst also considering the legacy they left within current British life now.

The children will use a range of resources to help them with their research and will link their history learning with Art, DT and English.

PHSE: Throughout this term we will be learning about rules and the impact that these have on differing societies with a focus on the features of democracy.

P.E:

To be taken outside whenever the weather allows this term the focus is based on 'invasion games' and developing strategies for attack and defence.

Music: In the rhythm builder unit for this term, we will be exploring rhythmic layers and getting to grips with time signatures whilst creating polyrhythmic textures.



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
