Mathematics (M)

Recognise numerals 1 to 10 and beyond
Count to 30
Count reliably numbers of objects to 10
Say the number that is one more than a given number
Recognise and continue a repeating pattern – create own patterns
Sequence familiar events
Say the days of the week in order
Begin to say the months in order

Understanding the World (UW)

Bonfire Night - The Gunpowder Plot
Thinking about how we celebrate - Birthdays/Weddings/Christmas
Divali – The Festival of Light
The story of Rama and Sita
Role play – Party Zone, Santa's Workshop
Small world – Bonfire night, Rama and Sita
Complete a simple program on the computer – Firework pictures
Operating a CD player

Communication and Language (CL)

Listening to stories which include: Rama and Sita, The Gunpowder Plot, Pass the Jam Jim, I want a Party, Yuk!, When Willy went to the Wedding, Cinderella, Jesus' Christmas Party, Hurry Santa and How many Sleeps till Christmas
Responding to 'how' and 'why' questions and simple instructions
Retelling events and simple stories
Taking part in circle time activities listening to others

Celebrations



A topic all about celebrating Bonfire night, Divali, Birthdays, Weddings, Anniversaries and Christmas.

Physical Development (PD)

Using physical equipment in various ways in our outdoor area
Fine motor control – using pens, paint brushes, play dough tools, scissors etc.
Manipulating materials to create using their imagination e.g. modelling materials/Lego
Changing for PE lessons
Taking part in 'celebration' themed music and movement sessions
Indoor multi – sports sessions

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

Taking turns and sharing resources
Forming good relationships with peers and familiar adults
Selecting activities and resources
Show confidence when asking for help
Adopt behaviour to different social situations and changes in routine

Literacy (L)

Letter formation – Phase 2 sounds
Phonics – Phase 2 sounds, blending and segmenting CVC words
Reading corner- Celebration books
Mark making and letter formation in the creative area, writing table and tuff spots and in outdoor area
Letter formation/writing name

Expressive arts and design (EAD)

Make bonfire toffee
Listening to Indian music
Create Rangoli patterns
Make Diva lamps
Sing songs and explore musical instruments
Play imaginatively with small word toys, role play and story props
