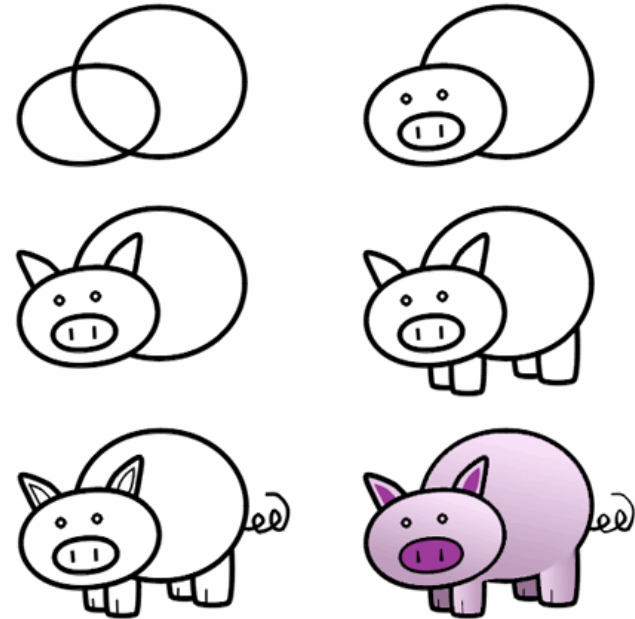


## Computing – [Purple Mash](#)
