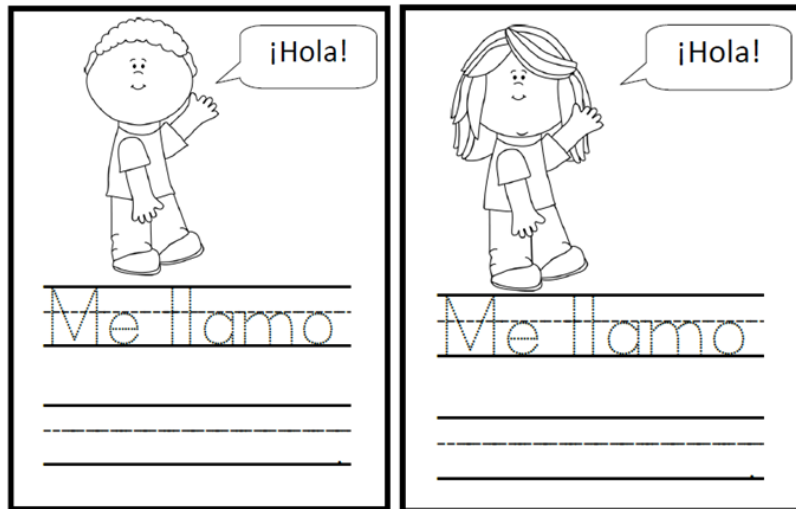


Spanish – Introducing yourself

The World – Biscuit investigation



What do you think might happen if the Gingerbread man fell into the river? Are you ready to carry out an experiment?

You will need:

3 or 4 different types of biscuits

A cup of tea or coffee

A timer (most phones have one)

What to do:

With the help of a grown up, dip one biscuit at a time in the hot drink. **Make sure you hold the biscuit right at the top so as not to burn your fingers!** Time how long it takes for the biscuit to go soggy and break...and maybe fall into the cup! Do the same thing with the other biscuits.

Can you record your results?

What do you notice?

Type of biscuit	Time taken to go soggy

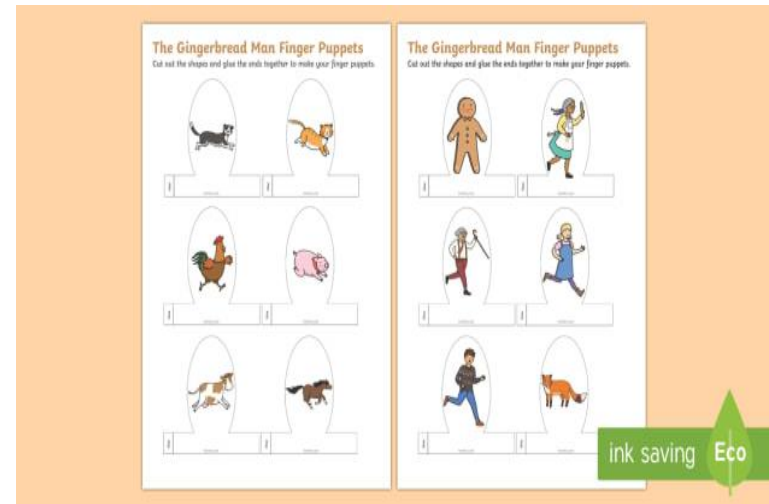
