Dear Parents/Carers

To support our science topic we would like to take the children on an educational visit to Magna Science Adventure Centre in Rotherham. We feel that this would really engage the children's interest and help their understanding of science.

Magna Science Adventure Centre is set in the former Templeborough steelworks in South Yorkshire. It is a vast building, a third of a mile long and 150 feet high. Four pavilions house over 100 hands-on exhibits themed on Air, Earth, Fire and Water, the 'elements' needed for making steel, where you can discover science, technology and the region's industrial heritage. The spectacular Big Melt Show re-creates the story of the steelworks and fabulous outdoor play facilities make for a great day out. Children will also be taking part in a practical workshop:

- **The Forces Show** - In our dynamic world everything that happens is caused by forces, but what better way to understand them than to investigate, fire, rockets, and even whirlpools. The show aims to motivate pupils to have a go, puzzle over problems and think through answers.

Our visit is arranged for **Tuesday 21st July 2026**. Children will need to arrive at school on time for a prompt 9.00am departure; we will return for the end of the school day at 3.30pm. On the day children will need to wear their **school uniform** and bring a **packed lunch and a water bottle for the day**.

We are asking for a contribution of **£26.25** per child. Payment must be made via Parentpay and can be paid by instalments if this is more convenient. Those families in receipt of free school meals may contact the office for alternative payment details. Whilst no child can be excluded for reasons of non-payment, the visit may have to be cancelled if there are insufficient funds.

We can offer children in receipt of free school meals a packed lunch for the day consisting of a sandwich, piece of fruit and cake (they will need to bring a water bottle). Please indicate on Parentpay if you would like to order one. **Lunch orders and payment will need to be in by Friday 26th June, please.**

As usual the local authority guidelines are followed and staffing/adult ratios are appropriate for the number and age of the children going on this visit. All the necessary risk assessments have been completed and appropriate safety measures are in place. However, under recent legislation we have to remind you that there are risks with any activity and that we expect the same high standards of behaviour from our pupils on visits as we do during the normal school day.
