- Sun cream applied before school (you are welcome to send a named bottle for reapplication if required)

Children will spend the afternoon in their Sports Day teams, moving around a range of activities and collecting points for their team. The only event completed in class groups will be the running races.

It is always a busy, energetic and enjoyable afternoon! To help everything run smoothly, children will remain with their teams throughout the event, so we kindly ask parents not to encourage them to come over during the activities.
