Reports for children in the Foundation Stage – Tiger Cubs 2026

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Later today you will receive your child's annual report via email.

As I shared earlier this year, our reports have been redesigned and reflect a new Trust approach to reporting to parents. This format has been developed to provide parents with clear, concise and meaningful information about their child's attainment and progress, whilst also reducing unnecessary teacher workload. This allows teachers to spend more of their time focusing on what has the greatest impact on pupils' learning and development.

The reports, as well as commenting on attainment and attendance, also include a personal comment from the class teacher about your child. Every one of your children have made a fantastic start on their education journey.

At the end of the EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage) teachers complete an assessment which is known as the **EYFS Profile**. This assessment is carried out by the reception teacher and is based on what they, and other staff caring for your child, have observed over a period of time. Your child has been acquiring new skills and knowledge and demonstrating their understanding through the seven **areas of learning and development** in the Early Years Foundation Stage.

Children should mostly develop the **three prime areas** first. These are:

- Communication and language
- Physical development
- Personal, social and emotional development

These prime areas are those most essential for your child's healthy development and future learning.

As children grow, the prime areas will help them to develop skills in **four specific areas**. These are:

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the world
- Expressive arts and design

All of the information collected is used to judge how your child is doing in the seven areas of learning and development. The report is organised so that Mrs Brown and Mrs Sharpe have assessed each of these seven areas and you will see whether for your child is currently working within the expected band for the end of the foundation stage or still emerging towards this goal.



Open Afternoon

We look forward to welcoming you to our Open Afternoon on **Wednesday 15th July from 2.00pm to 5.00pm.**

This is an opportunity to visit your child's classroom, celebrate their achievements by looking through their work together and, if you wish, take your child home following your visit.

If you would like to discuss your child's annual report with their class teacher, they will be available during the afternoon. However, as teachers will remain responsible for pupils until the end of the school day, we kindly ask that any conversations about reports take place after 3.30pm, when they are able to give you their full attention.

Thank you for your continued support throughout the year. We are incredibly proud of everything the children have achieved and hope you enjoy celebrating their successes with them.
