Reports for children in Year 4 – Lynx 2026

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Later today you will receive your child's annual report via email.

As I shared earlier this year, our reports have been redesigned and reflect a new Trust approach to reporting to parents. This format has been developed to provide parents with clear, concise and meaningful information about their child's attainment and progress, whilst also reducing unnecessary teacher workload. This allows teachers to spend more of their time focusing on what has the greatest impact on pupils' learning and development.

Your child's report includes:

- * their prior attainment and current attainment in the core curriculum areas;
- * their attitude to learning;
- * an explanation of what each attainment judgement means;
- * their attendance information; and
- * a personalised comment from their class teacher.

Although the report looks different from those you may have received in previous years, it has been designed to provide the key information parents need about their child's progress. Throughout the year we have also shared information through parents' evenings, Class Dojo, curriculum information and our day-to-day communication. The annual report therefore provides a concise summary alongside the wider discussions and updates you have already received.

Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)

Today your child will also bring home the results of their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). The MTC is a statutory assessment for all pupils in Year 4 and is designed to assess how quickly and accurately children can recall their multiplication facts up to 12×12 .

The check is intended to identify whether pupils have developed secure times table recall, which is an essential foundation for future learning in mathematics. The test is out of 25.

We are incredibly proud of the effort and resilience shown by all of our Year 4 pupils throughout the assessment period and thank you for your continued support with practising times tables at home.



Open Afternoon

We look forward to welcoming you to our Open Afternoon on **Wednesday 15th July from 2.00pm to 5.00pm.**

This is an opportunity to visit your child's classroom, celebrate their achievements by looking through their work together and, if you wish, take your child home following your visit.

If you would like to discuss your child's annual report with their class teacher, they will be available during the afternoon. However, as teachers will remain responsible for pupils until the end of the school day, we kindly ask that any conversations about reports take place after 3.30pm, when they are able to give you their full attention.

Thank you for your continued support throughout the year. We are incredibly proud of everything the children have achieved and hope you enjoy celebrating their successes with them.
