Reports for children in Year 6 – Tigers 2026

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Due to the Government delay with SATS results your child's annual report and SATs results will not come out to you until Friday 17th July. You will receive this report via email.

As I shared earlier this year, our reports have been redesigned and reflect a new Trust approach to reporting to parents. This format has been developed to provide parents with clear, concise and meaningful information about their child's attainment and progress, whilst also reducing unnecessary teacher workload. This allows teachers to spend more of their time focusing on what has the greatest impact on pupils' learning and development.

Your child's report includes:

- * their prior attainment and current attainment in the core curriculum areas;
- * their attitude to learning;
- * an explanation of what each attainment judgement means;
- * their attendance information; and
- * a personalised comment from their class teacher.

Although the report looks different from those you may have received in previous years, it has been designed to provide the key information parents need about their child's progress. Throughout the year we have also shared information through parents' evenings, Class Dojo, curriculum information and our day-to-day communication. The annual report therefore provides a concise summary alongside the wider discussions and updates you have already received.

Open Afternoon

We look forward to welcoming you to our Open Afternoon on **Wednesday 15th July from 2.00pm to 5.00pm.**

This is an opportunity to visit your child's classroom, celebrate their achievements by looking through their work together and, if you wish, take your child home following your visit.

Thank you for your continued support throughout the year. We are incredibly proud of everything the children have achieved and hope you enjoy celebrating their successes with them.

SATS Test Results

The report will also includes **test results** for; English, mathematics, and **teacher assessment** judgements for writing and science.

Your child will have taken tests in maths, reading and grammar, punctuation and spelling in May.



We report these test results, as all other schools do, as a scaled score for each subject.

- A scaled **score of 100** means a child is **working at the expected standard** for the end of the key stage.
- A scaled score **below 100** indicates that a child is **working below the expected standard** for the key stage.
- A scaled score **above 100** suggests a child is **working above the expected standard** for the key stage.

Teacher assessment

In addition to taking the tests, your child's teacher has assessed how well your child has done during the year in writing and science. This has been done using a framework that describes what a child needs to do to be working at the expected standard in a subject. Your child's teacher has based the assessment on the work that your child has done in class across the school year.

For **writing**, the teacher assessment will record that children are:

- working towards the expected standard and needs some support to meet national expectations
- working at the expected standard
- working at greater depth within the expected standard and has a strong understanding of the curriculum.

For science teacher assessment will record that children are:

- working at the expected standard or
- has not met the expected standard

The current Year 6 has been a terrific year group, and we know that they have all worked extremely hard.

To recognise their success, **we would like to invite you to A Celebration of Year 6 2026 at their Leaving Assembly on Friday 24th July at 9.30am**. This usually lasts for about an hour; afterwards you are invited to stay for refreshments. I look forward to seeing you there.
