Y1 Victorian Experience at Beaumanor Hall



Dear Parents/Carers

We are delighted to inform you that, as part of our Victorian topic, we will be visiting the historically significant **Beaumanor Hall in Leicestershire**. This visit will offer the children a fascinating insight into what life was like for school children and servants during the Victorian period, greatly enriching their learning and understanding of this topic.

To make the experience even more enjoyable, we will be attending in **Victorian-style costumes**. Further details about costumes will be shared closer to the date.

Our visit is scheduled for **Tuesday 28th April 2026**. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time, as we will be departing promptly at **9:00 am**. We aim to return before the end of the school day.

The cost of the visit is **£32.50 per child**, payable via **ParentPay**. Payments may be made in instalments if preferred. Families in receipt of free school meals may contact the school office for alternative payment arrangements. While no child will be excluded due to non-payment, the visit may need to be cancelled if we do not receive sufficient contributions. Please note that, as the cost of the visit is pre-set, we are unable to offer refunds.

As KS1 pupils are entitled to Government-funded meals, we can provide a **packed lunch** for the day. This will include a sandwich, a piece of fruit, and a cake. Children will also need to bring their water bottle. When making payment on ParentPay, please indicate **Yes/No** to a school lunch, and if 'Yes', choose a sandwich option: **cheese, ham, or tuna**. **All lunch orders and payments must be completed by Tuesday 14th April.**

All local authority guidelines will be followed, including appropriate staffing ratios for the age and number of children attending. Full risk assessments have been completed, and all necessary safety measures are in place. However, we must remind you that all activities carry some level of risk, and we expect pupils to demonstrate the same high standard of behaviour as they would during a normal school day.
